## Financials & other business

- Pre-Charge Conference was conducted and it was voted to accept the following items as presented: Clergy
  Compensation; Clergy Retirement & UMPIP Plan Resolution; Clergy Health Plan Resolution;
  Accountable Reimbursement Policy; and Nominations for Leadership.
- During the month of September, we received \$8,865.13 in identified giving and spent \$11,811.69 in operational expenses for a difference of -\$2946.56.
- It was voted to combine several smaller designated funds that were previously identified for specific missions into one fund entitled "Community Missions and Ministries".
- An updated **Facilities Use Policy** was adopted. The usage fee for the fellowship hall was set at to \$50/hour for for-profit groups and non-member individuals, as well as a cleaning fee of \$75.
