NLCC Administrative Council Meeting Recap: October 7, 2024

Missions & Ministries

- The Nurture committee is continuing the “**Do Unto Others**” **kindness campaign** through the month of October. Yard signs have been given to church members, along with calendars for children and adults encouraging acts of kindness; a small group study begins this week. - **KFC (Kids for Christ)** will host the “**National Day Out**” on October 12 from 2-4 pm with the Sheriff’s Office; they will provide fingerprinting and bring one of their dogs; we will serve nachos, drinks, and candy. KFC will also host a Halloween-themed luncheon after church on October 27. All children from kindergarten through 5th grade are invited to attend KFC on Sunday mornings at 10:00 AM.
- We are continuing to add new **Life Groups** and participation in small groups and other ministry opportunities is growing! Follow us on Facebook for details on ongoing Life Groups.
- This year we will conduct a **Thanksgiving “breakfast item” food drive** to provide families in our community with healthy breakfast items during the Thanksgiving break. A list of suggested donation items will be provided; gift cards will also be collected that families can use to buy perishable items like milk and eggs.

Financials & other business

- **Pre-Charge Conference** was conducted and it was voted to accept the following items as presented: Clergy Compensation; Clergy Retirement & UMPIP Plan Resolution; Clergy Health Plan Resolution; Accountable Reimbursement Policy; and Nominations for Leadership.
- During the month of September, we received **\$8,865.13 in identified giving** and spent **\$11,811.69 in operational expenses** for a difference of -\$2946.56.
- It was voted to combine several smaller designated funds that were previously identified for specific missions into one fund entitled “**Community Missions and Ministries**”.
- An updated **Facilities Use Policy** was adopted. The usage fee for the fellowship hall was set at to \$50/hour for for-profit groups and non-member individuals, as well as a cleaning fee of \$75.
